Angie McDunn has made the study of canine behavior a lifetime endeavor and she has 15 years experience. She is a graduate of MSU-Bozeman and it was during college that she began her pursuit of understanding more about canine behavior. Angie's first dog was an extremely high-drive, dominant, male Rottweiler and it was through working with him and attending seminars by trainers like Ivan Balabinov, Dean Calderon, Jim Elder and others that she gained much knowledge and experience. Angle has trained dogs for Schutzhund competition (originally a breed suitability test for German Shepherds), obedience competition, tracking, personal protection, and done behavior modification training. Angie's training philosophy promotes establishing a proper relationship between the dog and owner/handler to achieve maximum results.

Troy Kechely founded Big Sky Rottweiler Rescue in 1997. That same year, he began volunteering at the Humane Society in Bozeman. During the first few years, he focused on working with any Rottweilers at the facility, but it wasn't long before staff asked him to work with other high-risk dogs. Through trial and error and careful observation, Troy developed techniques for handling these types of dogs and modifying their behavior so they became adoptable. Three years later, the shelter asked Troy to instruct staff and other volunteers on the proper methods for handling dogs in a kennel environment and to avoid bite situations. In 2003, Troy started Think Dog **Consulting** and began offering training to shelters and boarding facilities throughout the Northern Rocky Mountain Region. He has also developed classes for the US Postal Service and Law Enforcement and Animal Control Officers.

Karen began her dog training experience as a volunteer with the Bozeman animal shelter almost ten years ago. Her skills as a trainer and handler led her to take on the most difficult dogs at the shelter with her emphasis on teaching them basic obedience and correcting their behavior problems. In 2002. she was asked to become the Assistant Instructor for the Dog Behavior and Handling class that all staff and volunteers had to take. During her four years in that position, she helped train over 100 volunteers and worked with countless dogs, many of which were deemed to have high-risk behavior.

Karen specializes in working with people in understanding dog behavior issues and teaching basic techniques for proper handling. Aside from her professional career as a project manager's assistant for a civil engineering firm, Karen still works with troubled dogs on a case-by-case basis.
